We promote and advocate the human right to food, obtained with dignity, respect and participation; promoting local solutions for food security; reducing food waste; and supporting community growth and integration.

This happens for many different reasons, but in a lot of cases it's not necessary. So we work with food distributors to rescue these items from across Canada.

After bringing the food to Manitoba we make it available for purchase through our retail store front in downtown Brandon. The revenue generated helps us to cover operational costs and ensures that we can continue to provide this much needed service.

We are not a fully stocked grocery store and every day is a little different as it depends on what has come in. Often you'll find commercial products, locally grown produce, handmade crafts and specialty food items.
